

In Section 4 there are over 500 drawings illustrating prepositions, verbs, passives, adjectives and nouns. In some cases you could copy the drawing onto the blackboard and use it to teach the meaning of the associated word. (See 'Teaching meaning with pictures' p 117). In other cases the picture is best used to contribute to an overall experience which helps the student appreciate the meaning of the associated language.

These drawings are more useful for practice than for presentation. The drawings can be used to cue alternatives in sentence patterns, or to cue answers to questions or as reference and the starting point for discussion, conversation and stories.
